We are honored for the opportunity to help you and your family through this difficult time. Please return the registration and diagnosis form to our office to begin using ACCA services.

Enclosed is a travel log to record your cancer-related appointments. For each visit, complete the entirety of the form: date, treatment center, and city, having a health care professional initial each visit. If you require transportation to an appointment, call our office to schedule. Rides are on a first-come, first-served basis and dependent on driver availability.

Cancer-related medication, medical and durable medical supplies, and nutritional supplement drinks, can be submitted for reimbursement by providing the following:

Prescriptions: Submit the receipt containing your name, prescribed drug, and out-of-pocket cost provided by the pharmacy after billing your insurance.

Medical Supplies: OTC medications, medical supplies, and durable medical items: Submit the cash register receipt with an explanation of all items purchased. You may submit the receipt for items purchased due to cancer, its treatment, or the treatments' side effects, e.g., nausea medication, gauze, wig, creams, etc. We have a variety of wigs in our office for free as well.

Nutritional Drinks: If a nutritional supplement drink is needed, we carry Boost in our office for clients. You may also submit the receipt if you purchase a nutritious supplement drink, and we will add it to your account for reimbursement.

Please submit your travel record and any prescription or medical supply receipt no later than the 10th of the given month to receive a check for the current month. Checks are sent monthly on the 20th. Our monthly budget dictates the maximum amount reimbursed to clients; this may vary monthly.
